This Beyond B.O.W. workshop is part of the "Becoming an Outdoors-Woman" (B.O.W.) program run by the Division. B.O.W. workshops are designed for women, yet open to anyone 18 years or older wishing to learn new outdoor skills, improve existing skills and/or enhance their appreciation of the outdoors.

This workshop offers participants the opportunity to learn the fundamentals of salt water fly fishing with licensed guide and veteran B.O.W. instructor Richard Kress. Richard will discuss equipment, teach a few essential knots and then focus on casting and stripping techniques.

Participants will try their hand at wetting a fly in the surf. All fishing equipment is provided; however, you may bring your own if you have it. Waders are nice but not necessary. A hat and eye protection (glasses or sunglasses will do) are a must.

Participants are invited to participate in the Governor's Surf Fishing Tournament taking place on Sunday, October 5 at Island Beach State Park. Equipment will be made available to B.O.W. participants for use during the tournament.

Both events will be held rain or shine so please dress appropriately for the weather.

Workshop Fee: \$40.00 includes equipment, instruction, and lunch.

Surf Fishing Tournament Registration: This workshop is held in conjunction with the Governor's Surf Fishing Tournament held on Sunday, October 5, 2003.
