This information will be used to better estimate the harvest of native versus stocked game birds in the State. We strongly feel this is an important issue and the results will enable the Division to better serve the citizens of our State.

Please note, failure to submit the Harvest Report with the Annual Report will delay the authorization and/or issuance of a Commercial and Semi-Wild Permit for the upcoming season.

Instructions

- 1) Commercial Preserve Permit annual reports and harvest reports are due May 31st.
- 2) If you can not supply the appropriate information to complete the form you should give a written explanation with the pertinent reasons why the information is not available.
- 3) A summary statement from your supplier(s), indicating the total number of each species purchased for the season, and full payment, must be submitted with this report form.
- 4) Daily stocking & kill sheets must be kept on the premises during the season and be readily available for inspection upon request . Submit a copy of your stocking and kill sheets with your reports.
- 5) Records must be retained and available for three (3) years.
- 6) If you raise your own birds under a Captive Game - Propagation and Sales permit, you must include a copy of your Captive Game Permit Annual Report or documentation, indicating the transfer of these birds to your Commercial Preserve.
- 7) Licenses will not be renewed until the Annual Report and the Harvest Report have been received, reviewed and approved.
- 8) Failure to file your Annual Report and Harvest Report in a timely manner may cause a delay in obtaining your new permit.
- 9) Only use the most current official Division of Fish and Wildlife forms. Copies of old forms may cause delays in the processing of your annual report and/or permit renewal form.
- 10) This form may be completed electronically, printed and submitted - or - you can print the form, complete and submit the form.
